CHARACTER	BRIEF BIO	SUGGESTED ATTIRE
<p><b>ALEX BLACK</b> Baker</p> <p><b>OPTIONAL</b> Either gender</p>	<p>Alex Black is the most famous baker in London. People flock to Alex's bread shop on Piccadilly Street. In addition to fresh bread and buns, Alex offers delicious scones, sponge cake, and shortbread. Alex is well-connected in the city, and nobody knows on which side of the law that Alex is truly aligned.</p>	<p><i>Late Victorian/Edwardian era attire fit for a baker. Not too flashy. If you wish to wear a baker's uniform from this era, that's also great.</i></p>
<p><b>BERTIE SOULE</b> Matchstick Maker</p> <p><b>OPTIONAL</b> Either gender</p>	<p>Bertie spends the days at the matchstick shop, cutting wood into thin sticks and dipping the ends in white phosphorous – a toxic chemical that is thought to shorten the human lifespan. Bertie works sixteen hours a day with no breaks. Bertie is desperately seeking a new opportunity in life. One thing is certain about this matchstick maker - Bertie doesn't follow Lord Blackstone...yet.</p>	<p><i>Late Victorian/Edwardian era attire fit for a matchstick maker. Not too flashy, boxes of matches as optional props.</i></p>
<p><b>KIT KELDGORD</b> Undertaker</p> <p><b>OPTIONAL</b> Either gender</p>	<p>As a child, Kit was a member of the London high society. However, the Keldgord name lost its luster when the patriarch of the family was found guilty of being a serial killer known as the <i>Thames Strangler</i>, who had terrorized the city for over a decade. As an adult, Kit holds an upstanding position as an undertaker for the most prominent funeral parlor in the city, <i>Holdsworth's Passing</i>.</p>	<p><i>Vintage Victorian/Edwardian style attire – all black. Be more mysterious by wearing a cloak.</i></p>
<p><b>OLLIE CABOT</b> Crossing-Sweeper</p> <p><b>OPTIONAL</b> Either gender</p>	<p>Ollie Cabot is a crossing-sweeper for Spencer Primrose, an aristocrat of London. Ollie travels with Lord Primrose and clears the way in front of him as he strolls down the street, sweeping the debris and soil from his path. Ollie is a bit of an entrepreneur, as Lord Primrose didn't have a sweeper before Ollie pitched the idea and created the job.</p>	<p><i>Late Victorian/Edwardian era attire fit for a cross sweeper. Not too flashy. Small broom as an optional prop.</i></p>
<p><b>SHANNON SMITH</b> Mudlark</p> <p><b>OPTIONAL</b> Either gender</p>	<p>Shannon Smith is a notorious thief of London, but Scotland Yard has never found enough evidence to put Shannon behind iron bars. Shannon claims to be a mudlark, which is a profession only a few dare to take on. Shannon dredges the scums of society and the Thames River for coins and treasures to sell, collecting anything that can be sold, such as driftwood, rags, etc.</p>	<p><i>Late Victorian/Edwardian era attire fit for a mudlark. You are a peasant, so wear dirty-looking attire.</i></p>
<p><b>VIC LOWELL</b> Apothecary Owner</p> <p><b>OPTIONAL</b> Either gender</p>	<p>Vic Lowell owns the <i>London Apothecary</i>, which is the shop in the center of the city that sells wine, spices, herbs, and medicine. Vic's family founded the store over a hundred years ago, and the Lowell family is known for providing Londoners with their basic needs. Vic is a caring person who dotes over a pet cat named Dotty.</p>	<p><i>Late Victorian/Edwardian era attire. You do have a little money, but not as much as an aristocrat, so moderately flashy/trendy is good.</i></p>
