Evergreen frequently says the catchphrase, 'Keep calm and wait for Santa' when things are not going well. Evergreen speaks with a high-pitched voice and is quick to give a compliment.	You are an elf. BING BALTHAZAR <i>Toymaker, Santa's Workshop</i> <i>Optional player</i>	Bing Balthazar is a lackadaisical toymaking elf who works in Santa's Workshop.
