A sassy western outfit with a hat and boots for the talent competition. A microphone (real or fake) and guitar (real or fake) as props.</p>
<p>PONI ALOHA <i>Miss Hawaii</i></p> <p>REQUIRED</p>	<p>The shy Miss Hawaii is one of the best Hawaiian dancers of her generation. She stars in one of the largest luau productions in Maui. Miss Aloha had to drop out of the competition last year due to a toenail injury, but she's more than ready to compete this year! Poni Aloha dances circles around her competitors.</p>	<p>Any dress for the evening gown competition. A Hawaiian shirt with a grass skirt and a flower in the hair for the talent competition.</p>	<p>To any Hawaiian music, choreograph a Hawaiian luau dance (Polynesian style dance).</p>

And a themed outfit to match your talent monologue.</p>	<p>Act out a monologue. You can pull a script off of the internet or write your own.</p>

Gretyl's one of the most talented and entertaining puppeteers in the United States!</p>	<p>Any dress for the evening gown competition. Ms. Morning knows the ins and outs of pageants. In the past decade since she was hired as the director, all pageants have run as smooth as butter.</p>	<p>An evening gown and a crown to display (it can be plastic) sitting on a satin pillow a prop.
