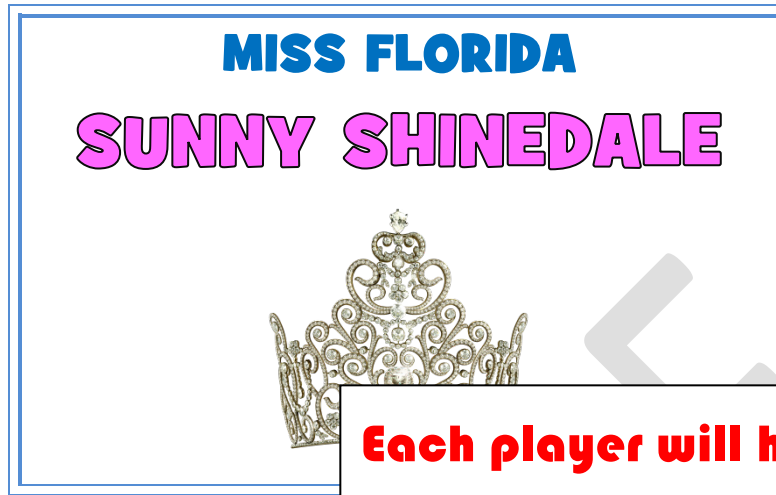

ROUND TWO: First, you'll host the talent competition. Then, make the announcement of crime. Deliver the clue cards while you serve a light dinner to your guests. The investigation of the crime commences.

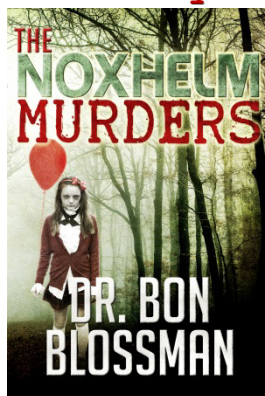
